**SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY CORNERSTONE RESEARCH
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH OR OTHERWISE
RESPOND TO SUBPOENA**

Non-party Cornerstone Research (“Cornerstone Research”) hereby moves for a second extension of time to March 30, 2023, to move to limit or quash or otherwise respond to the subpoena served on Cornerstone Research by Activision Blizzard, Inc. (“Activision”) on March 3, 2023 (the “Subpoena”). Activision consents to the relief requested in this motion. This is Cornerstone Research’s second request for an extension.

Activision served Cornerstone Research with the Subpoena on March 3, 2023, with a production date of March 13, 2023. Activision and Cornerstone Research met and conferred regarding the Subpoena on March 9, 2023, during which meeting Activision agreed to extend Cornerstone Research’s time to respond to the Subpoena. On March 13, 2023, Cornerstone Research filed the Unopposed Motion of Non-Party Cornerstone Research for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash or Otherwise Respond to Subpoena (“First Unopposed Motion”), and Activision consented to the relief requested in the First Unopposed Motion. The Court granted

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the First Unopposed Motion on March 15, 2023, extending Cornerstone Research's deadline to file a motion to quash or limit Activision's subpoena to March 23, 2023.

Activision and Cornerstone Research met and conferred again regarding the Subpoena on March 22, 2023, and Activision stated it consented to the relief requested in this second motion.

Because discussions between Cornerstone Research and Activision remain ongoing, Cornerstone Research requests a second extension of its deadline to move to limit or quash or otherwise respond to the Subpoena pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c) so that Cornerstone Research and Activision can continue their discussions and hopefully eliminate or narrow any issues that may need to be presented to the Court for resolution.

Pursuant to the January 4, 2023 Scheduling Order, Activision has until April 7, 2023 to complete fact discovery, and, therefore, Cornerstone Research does not believe the requested extension will delay the progress of these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, Cornerstone Research respectfully requests that Your Honor grant the requested relief pursuant to 16 C.F.R. § 4.3(b).

**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR

On March 13, 2023, non-party Cornerstone Research filed a motion to extend the time for it to file a motion to quash or limit a subpoena served on Cornerstone Research by Respondent Activision Blizzard, Inc. (“Activision”) (“First Motion”). The Court granted the First Motion on March 15, 2023, extending Cornerstone Research’s deadline to file a motion to quash or limit Activision’s subpoena to March 23, 2023.

On March 23, 2023, non-party Cornerstone Research filed a second motion to extend the time for it to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena served on Cornerstone Research by Respondent Activision (“Second Motion”) to March 30, 2023.

Cornerstone Research states that Activision and Cornerstone Research are engaged in ongoing negotiations and that further negotiations may narrow or eliminate areas of dispute. Cornerstone Research further states that Activision agrees to the extension requested in the Second Motion.

Upon review and consideration of the Motion, the Motion is GRANTED. It is hereby

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ORDERED that Cornerstone Research's deadline to file a motion to quash or limit Activision's subpoena is extended to March 30, 2023.
