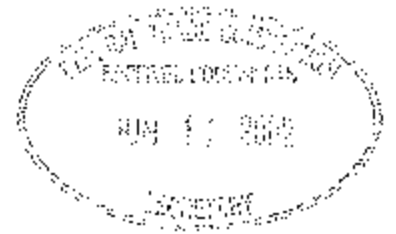

MODIFICATIONS TO SCHEDULING ORDER


On June 11, 2002, Respondent MSC.Software Corp. filed an unopposed motion to amend the revised scheduling order. That motion is GRANTED. The following alterations will be made:

- June 17, 2002 - Deadline for filing motions *in limine* and motions to strike.
- June 18, 2002 - Respondent's Counsel provides to Complaint Counsel its final proposed witness and exhibit lists, including designated testimony to be presented by deposition and counter designations to Complaint Counsel's designations, and copies of all exhibits (except for demonstrative, illustrative or summary exhibits), and a brief summary of the testimony of each witness.

Respondent's Counsel serves courtesy copies on ALJ its final proposed witness and exhibit lists, including a list of designated testimony and counter designations to be presented by deposition, and a brief summary of the testimony of each witness.
- June 24, 2002 - Exchange, and serve courtesy copy on ALJ, objections to final proposed witness lists and exhibits, including objections to the designated testimony to be presented by deposition.
- June 25, 2002 - Deadline for filing responses to motions *in limine* and motions to strike.
- June 27, 2002 - Exchange proposed stipulations of law, facts, and authenticity.

July 1, 2002 - File final stipulations of law, facts, and authenticity. Any subsequent stipulations may be filed as agreed by the parties.
