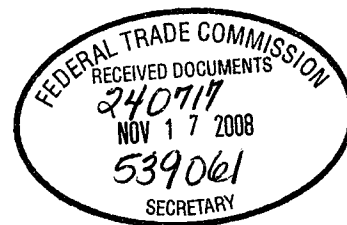

**ORDER ON NON-PARTY ENERSYS' MOTION TO EXTEND
TIME IN WHICH TO MOVE TO LIMIT SUBPOENA SERVED BY
RESPONDENT AND TO SEEK COST REIMBURSEMENT**

On November 17, 2008, non-party EnerSys filed a motion to extend the time in which to move to limit the subpoena served on it by Respondent and to extend the time in which to seek cost reimbursement. EnerSys states that Complaint Counsel has reviewed the motion and authorized EnerSys to represent that Complaint Counsel takes no position on the motion. EnerSys also states that Respondent has reviewed the motion and authorized EnerSys to represent that Respondent has no objection to the extension of time requested by the motion, but that Respondent does not agree that EnerSys is entitled to recover the costs of reviewing and gathering documents for production. EnerSys' motion is GRANTED.

It is hereby ORDERED that the time in which EnerSys may object to the subpoena served upon it by Respondent is extended to December 16, 2008.
