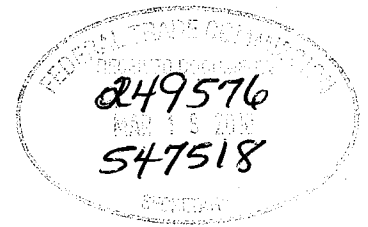

**UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Non-party Hewlett-Packard Company (“HP”) files this motion to extend the time permitted for HP to move to limit the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Complaint Counsel.

Complaint Counsel served HP with the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* on Monday, March 8, 2010. Under the applicable procedures of the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, the time to file a Motion to Limit or Quash Complaint Counsel’s Subpoena *Duces Tecum* is March 18, 2010.

Complaint Counsel has agreed to an extension of time for HP to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* through March 29, 2010, while the parties try to reach agreement on the scope of the Subpoena *Duces Tecum*.

Accordingly, HP respectfully requests that this Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time be granted and that HP be given until March 29, 2010 to file a Motion to Quash or Limit Complaint Counsel’s Subpoena *Duces Tecum*.
