Pursuant to Rule 3.25(b) of the Rules of Practice of the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC Rules"), 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(b), Complaint Counsel and Counsel for the Respondents (collectively "the Parties") jointly move to withdraw Docket No. 9348 from adjudication for the purpose of considering the proposed attached Consent Proposal and further move, pursuant to Rule 3.25(c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, that the Administrative Law Judge certify the motion and Consent Proposal to the Commission.

Complaint Counsel and Respondents represent that the Consent Proposal details the agreed upon material terms and there exists a "reasonable possibility of settlement" in accordance with Rule 3.25(b). The Parties also note that they have stipulated to a Preliminary Injunction that has been entered by U.S. District Court Judge W. Louis Sands on June 5, 2013, halting further integration and maintaining the *status quo*. Thus, the Parties request the matter
