Thank you for your comment regarding the proposed consent order accepted by the Federal Trade Commission for public comment in the above-captioned matter. In your comment, you expressed a concern about fuel prices in Whitney Point, New York, if Mirabito acquired a station there. The proposed consent order contemplates that Sunoco LP, not Mirabito, will acquire the station that the Commission is requiring the parties to divest in Whitney Point.

The Commission has placed your comment on the public record pursuant to Rule 4.9(b)(6)(ii) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 4.9(b)(6)(ii).
