### JOINT MOTION TO WITHDRAW MATTER FROM ADJUDICATION

Pursuant to Sections 3.25(b) and (c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(b), (c), Complaint Counsel and Counsel for Respondent Safariland, LLC ("Respondent Safariland") jointly move to withdraw Respondent Safariland from adjudication in Docket No. 9389 for the purpose of the Commission's consideration of a proposed consent agreement that would resolve all of the claims against Respondent Safariland set forth in the Complaint.

Complaint Counsel and Respondent Safariland understand that the matter is currently stayed under the Commission's Order Regarding Scheduling in Light of Public Health Emergency, March 19, 2020. The proposed consent agreement does not impact the Commission's action again Respondent Axon Enterprise, Inc., and the adjudication should continue unabated with respect to Respondent Axon Enterprise, Inc. The proposed consent agreement, which is attached and conforms to the requirements of Commission Rule of Practice 2.32, has been executed by

Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(b), that the proposed Consent Agreement shall not be placed on the

public record unless and until it is accepted by the Commission; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 3.25(e) of the Commission Rules of

Practice, 16 C.F.R. § 3.25(e), that all claims against Respondent Axon Enterprise, Inc. in this

matter will remain in an adjudicative status.
