**ORDER GRANTING NON-PARTY PHILLIP MORRIS INTERNATIONAL  
INC.’S SECOND MOTION FOR *IN CAMERA* TREATMENT**

On June 22, 2021, non-party Phillip Morris International Inc. (“PMI”) filed a second motion for *in camera* treatment for one document that Respondents intend to offer into evidence. No party opposes the motion. For the reasons set forth below, PMI’s motion is GRANTED.

The standards by which PMI’s motion is evaluated are set forth in the Order on Non-Parties’ Motions for *In Camera* Treatment, issued May 26, 2021. PMI seeks *in camera* treatment for a period of five years for one additional document identified for the record as RX2080. PMI supports its motion with a declaration from an assistant general counsel. The declaration provides details about the information PMI seeks to protect and explains how the information meets the *in camera* treatment standards. Accordingly, *in camera* treatment, for a period of five years, to expire June 1, 2026, is GRANTED for RX2080.
