Dear Mr. Chaykin:

We received your submissions of September 17, 2014, October 13, 2014, and January 8, 2015, on behalf of Aeromotive Inc. ("Aeromotive"). During our review, we discussed that statements in Aeromotive's marketing materials may have overstated the extent to which certain auto parts containing imported content were made in the United States.

In your submissions, you explained that Aeromotive implemented a remedial action plan to correct its representations. This plan included removing U.S.-origin claims from all marketing materials and product packaging.

Based on your statements, the staff has decided not to pursue this investigation any further. This action should not be construed as a determination that there was no violation of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45.
