Dear Mr. Kier:

We received your submissions of February 16, 2015, February 27, 2015, March 25, 2015, and April 8, 2015, on behalf of Platinum Pets, Inc. ("Platinum Pets" or the "Company"). During our review, we discussed concerns that marketing materials may have overstated the extent to which certain Platinum Pets products are made in the United States. You clarified that, although Platinum Pets imports some product inputs, the Company conducts significant manufacturing activities – including color-processing for its pet bowls – in the United States.

As we discussed, unqualified "Made in USA" claims likely suggest to consumers that products are "all or virtually all" made in the United States. In response to our inquiry, you explained that Platinum Pets: (1) conducted an extensive review of its marketing materials, including claims made through third-party websites and social media, and (2) updated marketing materials to remove overly broad claims and, where applicable, to identify specific manufacturing processes that the Company performs in the United States.

Based on your statements, the staff has decided not to pursue this investigation any further. This action should not be construed as a determination that there was no violation of Section 5 of the Federal Trade Commission Act, 15 U.S.C. § 45.
