Most recent Independent Assessor's Report on Google's Privacy Program

Dear Mr. Kick:

This is in response to your request dated January 10, 2018, under the Freedom of Information Act seeking access to the most recent Independent Assessor's Report on Google's Privacy Program and updates on Google's initial compliance report regarding AdWords API Terms and Conditions. In accordance with the FOIA and agency policy, we have searched our records as of January 10, 2018, the date we received your request in our FOIA office.

We have located 58 pages of responsive records. I am granting partial access to the records, portions of which are exempt from disclosure under FOIA Exemption 4, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4), because they constitute confidential commercial or financial information. See Critical Mass Energy Project v. NRC, 975 F.2d 871, 879 (D.C. Cir. 1992). Moreover, because Section 6(f) of the FTC Act, 15 U.S.C. § 46(f), prohibits public disclosure of this type of information, it is also exempt under FOIA Exemption 3, 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(3), which exempts from disclosure any information that is protected from disclosure under another federal statute.
