- JUDGE CHAPPELL: Okay, let's go on the record.
- 4 THE REPORTER: We are on the record.
- 5 JUDGE CHAPPELL: This is the initial prehearing
- 6 conference in Docket Number 9392, in the matter of
- 7 Thomas Jefferson University and Albert Einstein
- 8 Healthcare Network.
- 9 I'm Judge Chappell. Can everyone hear me okay?
- 10 MR. SEIDMAN: Yes, Your Honor.
- 11 MR. DICKINSON: Yes, Your Honor.
- 12 JUDGE CHAPPELL: This prehearing conference is
- 13 being conducted telephonically and is being transcribed
- 14 by a court reporter who is on the line with us. Will
- 15 the court reporter please state your name for the
- 16 record?
- 17 THE REPORTER: Susanne Bergling with For The
- 18 Record, Inc.
- 19 JUDGE CHAPPELL: I will need everyone to mute
- 20 their phones when they're not speaking.
- 21 I will now take appearances of the individuals
- 22 designated to speak for the parties, and I need you to
- 23 identify who is on the call. We will start with
- 24 Complaint Counsel.
- 25 MR. SEIDMAN: Good afternoon, Your Honor. This

- is Mark Seidman on behalf of Complaint Counsel, and I'm
- 2 joined by my colleague Charles Dickinson.
- JUDGE CHAPPELL: For Respondents?
- 4 MR. SAINT-ANTOINE: For Respondent Thomas
- 5 Jefferson University, Your Honor, you have Paul
- 6 Saint-Antoine from the Faegre Drinker Biddle & Reath
- 7 firm, and my colleague Alison Agnew.
- 8 JUDGE CHAPPELL: All right.
- 9 MS. OLIVER: Good afternoon, Your Honor. For
- 10 Albert Einstein Healthcare Network, you have Leigh
- 11 Oliver from Hogan Lovells, and I am joined by my
- 12 partner Virginia Gibson.
- JUDGE CHAPPELL: All right, thank you.
- 14 Also on the line with me are my
- 15 attorney-advisors, and since we're doing this
- 16 telephonically, I'm asking everyone who makes a
- 17 statement, before you speak, you need to identify
- 18 yourself for the court reporter. I don't do that
- 19 because, Susanne, you can recognize my voice. Am I
- 20 correct?
- THE REPORTER: Yes, Your Honor.
- JUDGE CHAPPELL: There is currently pending a
- 23 preliminary injunction proceeding in the Federal
- 24 District Court in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.
- 25 According to our information, the court docket has a

- 1 final pretrial conference scheduled for September 10,
- 2 2020. I need the parties to keep us informed of any
- 3 substantive decisions in that case.
- Who wants to give me an update on that case?
- 5 MR. SEIDMAN: Your Honor, Mark Seidman on
- 6 behalf of Complaint Counsel. You're right, the final
- 7 prehearing conference is set for September 10th, and
- 8 the preliminary injunction hearing is set to begin on
- 9 September 14th. We are currently in the midst of
- 10 discovery in that case, and fact discovery closes on
- 11 July 20th.
- 12 JUDGE CHAPPELL: Okay. Is the judge in that
- 13 case aware that the way things work here, it's best if
- 14 you can get a ruling on that issue before our trial
- 15 date?
- 16 MR. SEIDMAN: Yes, Your Honor. We have
- 17 discussed with Judge Pappert in the Eastern District of
- 18 Pennsylvania the timing of the administrative trial.
- 19 He's aware of it.
- 20 JUDGE CHAPPELL: All right, thank you.
- 21 The parties were provided a draft scheduling
- 22 order and no changes were requested, so that order will
- 23 be issued shortly.
- I trust the parties have attempted to settle
- 25 this matter. Who wants to provide a status of

- 1 settlement discussions?
- 2 MR. SEIDMAN: Your Honor, Mark Seidman again
- 3 for Complaint Counsel. The parties had several
- 4 discussions regarding settlement towards the end of the
- 5 investigation period. Those discussions were not
- 6 successful.
- We briefly revisited that discussion last week,
- 8 and I don't believe there's been any movement on --
- 9 from either side, but I will let Respondents speak from
- 10 their perspectives.
- 11 JUDGE CHAPPELL: All right, go ahead.
- MR. SAINT-ANTOINE: Your Honor, this is Paul
- 13 Saint-Antoine for Respondent Thomas Jefferson
- 14 University.
- 15 Mr. Seidman's description is accurate from our
- 16 perspective, both the timing and the status of any
- 17 settlement discussions.
- 18 JUDGE CHAPPELL: All right.
- 19 Anything from Einstein?
- 20 MS. OLIVER: And this is Leigh Oliver from
- 21 Einstein, and that's correct; that is, Mr. Seidman's
- 22 description is accurate.
- JUDGE CHAPPELL: Okay, and we're not hearing
- 24 case summaries today. We have now completed the main
- 25 purpose of this hearing, which is the scheduling order,

- 1 which will be issued shortly.
- 2 Is there anything further?
- 3 MR. SEIDMAN: Not from Complaint Counsel, Your
- 4 Honor.
- 5 MR. SAINT-ANTOINE: Not from Thomas Jefferson
- 6 University either, Your Honor. We appreciate you
- 7 adjusting the agenda in light of the deposition
- 8 schedule.
- 9 MS. OLIVER: And Leigh Oliver for Einstein,
- 10 nothing further from us either. Thank you.
- JUDGE CHAPPELL: All right, and you're welcome.
- 12 Hearing nothing further, we are adjourned.
- MR. SEIDMAN: Thank you, Your Honor.
- MR. SAINT-ANTOINE: Thank you, Your Honor.
- 15 MS. OLIVER: Thank you.
- 16 (Whereupon, at 3:07 p.m., the remote hearing
- 17 was adjourned.)
