Re: Advertising Claims by Solar D Skincare, LLC

Dear Ms. Levine:

I am writing to follow up on your referral to the FTC of the above-mentioned matter. Your referral indicated that Solar D Skincare, LLC, the advertiser for Solar D sunscreen, declined to participate in the NAD's self-regulatory process.

After we contacted the company regarding the NAD referral, it agreed to cooperate with the NAD's inquiry. Subsequently, however, the NAD decided to close its inquiry into the challenged claims.

Accordingly, it appears no additional FTC action is warranted at this time. Our decision is not to be construed as a determination that a violation has not occurred. The Commission reserves the right to take such further action as the public interest may require. The FTC fully supports the NAD's self-regulatory process, and we appreciate your referral and the opportunity to continue to assist in supporting the NAD.
